
Allan Botschinsky - born 29.03.1940 in Copenhagen <u>www.allanbotschinsky.com</u>

Allan Botschinsky's career as an outstanding talent was extensively documented in Denmark until he moved away in 1984, to play with Peter Herbolzheimer's Rhythm Combination & Brass and Ali Haurand's European Jazz Ensemble.

Allan moved to Hamburg in 1984 He married his third wife, music producer Marion Kaempfert in 1990 They lived in Germany, Tuscany, London, and Switzerland He retired from his professional life in 2015 He moved back to Denmark in 2017 and now lives on the island of Læsø
